**AGREED ORDER
AUTHORIZING CONTINUED USE OF EXISTING BANK ACCOUNTS
Resolving Docket #21**

Upon the Agreed Amended Expedited Motion for an Order Authorizing Continued Use of Existing Bank Accounts pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§105(a) and 366 filed by the Debtor, and the Court being satisfied, based on the statements contained in such motion that the requested relief is necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the Debtor, its estate and its creditors, and it appearing that sufficient notice of the Motion has been given, and no other further notice is required; and after due consideration, it is

ORDERED that the Debtor is authorized to (a) maintain and continue to use any or all of his existing bank accounts in the names and with the account numbers existing immediately prior to this Chapter11 case – specifically : (a) checking account number xxxx3003 at Bank of America; (b) savings account number xxxx8705 at Bank of America and (c) checking/savings account number xxxx4565 at Wachovia Bank; provided that the Debtor is authorized continued use of any or all of his pre-petition bank accounts (b) deposit funds in and withdraw funds from

any such accounts by all usual means including, but not limited to, checks, wire transfers, electronic funds transfers; and (c) treat his pre-petition bank accounts (and any accounts opened post-petition) for all purposes as Debtor-in-Possession. It is further:

ORDERED that the Court is waiving the requirement of the Debtor having to immediately purchase new checks that include the term "Debtor in Possession" and the case number assigned to this chapter 11 case for administrative purposes. The Debtor may issue his existing checks in the ordinary course of business and Debtor is **NOT** required to notate "Debtor in Possession" or list the chapter 11 case number under which this case will be administered on any of his personal checks or savings accounts. It is further:

ORDERED that notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the authority granted herein is subject to any requirements and limitations imposed upon the Debtor under any Court order regarding the use of cash collateral and any approved budget contained therein and that nothing contained herein shall, or shall be deemed to, modify, amend or alter such order or approved budget.


